#### Vegetable garden tomatoes with outstanding quality

From our own breeding, several varieties of Tomatoes have been developed: Cherry, Cocktail Round and Beef. While breeding these varieties, we paid attention to several factors. In Tomatoes, productivity and strong garden performance are key. Our tomatoes have phytophthora resistance.

#### **Beef tomato pink**

This variety produces big tomatoes which are very juicy. Big juicy tomatoes of 150 gram

#### Mini Plum tomato red

Productive variety can be harvest as trusses. Fruits between 10-15 gram which have a good bite and taste.

#### **Cocktail tomato red and yellow**

Wow, what a productive variety this is! The production starts early and keeps on gowing until the end of summer. The 40 grams tomatoes have a good texture and can be used for many purposes.

#### **Round tomato red**

This is a real upgrade in the round tomatoes. Strong plants that keep up well in the garden. Productive and tasteful round tomatoes of 70 grams.

#### **Cherry tomato red**

Different varieties which produce beautiful trusses of very aromatic 10 grams tomatoes. This enables the home gardener to grow professional-quality at home.

There are lots of busy bees at work around our greenhouses. These bumblebees ensure the plant's fruits are pollinated as nature intended. This means the flowers on the tomato plants are pollinated by the bumblebees, allowing the fruit to grow. Other beneficial insects are used as well as bumblebees. These 'good' insects help to ward off harmful insects in a very natural way.

#### Certification

To help maintain food safety, all our Pick-&-Joy® vegetable plants are certified to the highest standards. Every year, we carry out a number of audits to ensure that the highest quality can be guaranteed, and that we are looking out for people, planet, and environment. This includes being aware of use of water, fertilizer and energy. Vreugdenhil Young Plants is certified MPS A, MPS-SQ, MPS Gap, Global Gap, and Grasp.
